Formalities for importing weapons and ammunition for EU and non-EU residents (form to be provided):

Import of Weapons for EU and NON EU Citizens.

While traveling within the European Union with firearms and/or ammunition a European Firearms Passport is required.

Competitors from EU countries

The person who have an EU firearms passport, do not require any further permits, from the Estonian Police and Border Guard Board, to travel to the Estonian Republic with firearms and/or ammunition. A letter of invitation that you are going to participate in a shooting competition in the Republic of Estonia, is necessary. The invitation must be presented together with the EU firearms passport at customs.

Competitors from non-EU countries must fill invitation form, send it to organizers in Estonia (info@ejsl.ee) to get Gun import license as soon as possible. A copy of the Invitation must be in your possession during your stay in Estonia.
