Thanks to many links you can easily reach others important cities such as Siena, Pisa and Lucca.



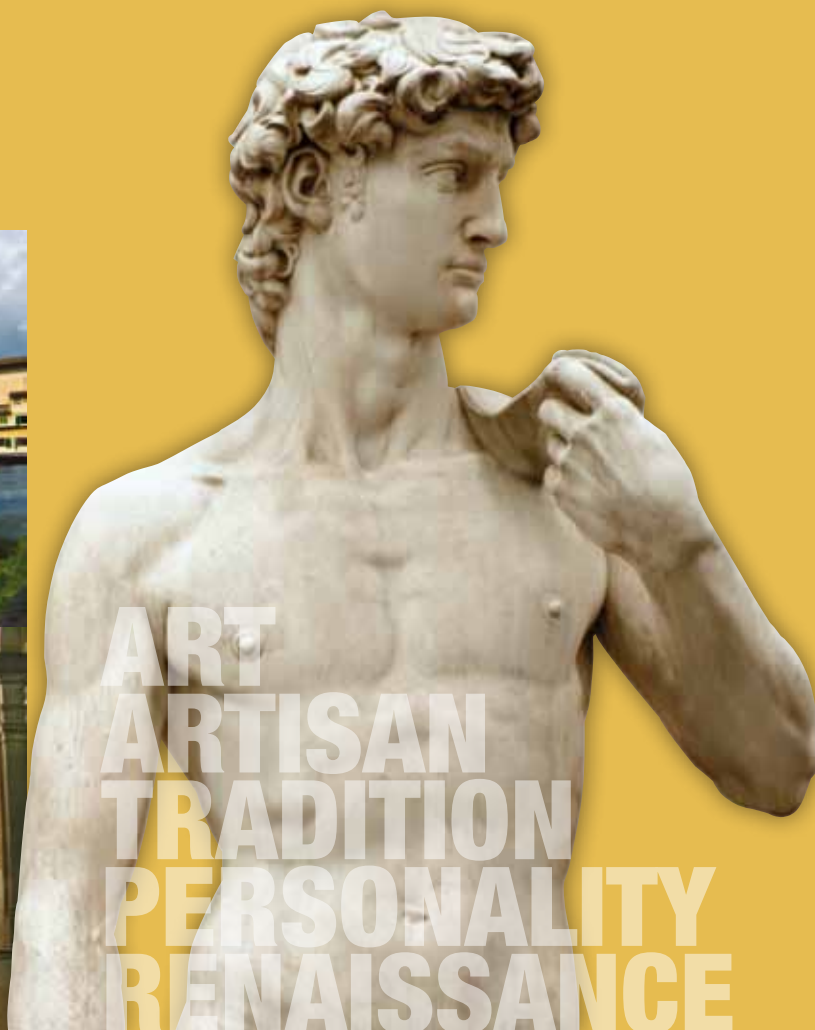

● FLORENCE the city of art

Cradle of the Renaissance and homeland of excellent artists, architects and literates, Florence preserves an incomparable and a legendary cultural heritage. Works of *Cimabue*, *Giotto*, *Brunelleschi*, *Donatello* and *Masaccio* the wide-ranging of *Leonardo* and *Michelangelo* are quite all collected in its many museums, as in *Galleria degli Uffizzi* which is known as the world's most selective art gallery. Florence's old town

has been declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1982 and it gathers all the most meaningful cultural heritages of the entire city, as an example the *Santa Maria del Fiore Cathedral* (the domed cathedral of the city), *Palazzo Vecchio* (Old Palace) and *Palazzo Pitti* (Pitti Palace), *Ponte Vecchio* (Old bridge) and the *Cappelle Medicee* (Medici Chapels). Thanks to the artistic complex of the city together with the culinary tradition and the wonderful surrounding Florence is considered a world's incomparable destination.
