GENERAL INFORMATION

1. THE RANGE

The competition will take place at the very well known Nicosia Olympic Shooting Range, in the area of Latsia, on the outskirts of Nicosia, the capital of Cyprus. Eight (8) layouts in total will be used for the competition.

The Range hosted very successfully several FITASC Grand Prix, the FITASC UT World Championship 2004, the European Compak Sporting Championship of 2010 and the World Championship of 2012.

The Olympic Shooting Range has full cafeteria and restaurant facilities that can offer meals, lunch, dinner etc. at very reasonable prices.



2. CATEGORIES

- Juniors: Born between 1st January 1997 and 31st December 2003
- Seniors: Born between 1st January 1962 and 31st December 1996
- Veterans: Born between 1st January 1952 and 31st December 1961
- Super Veterans: Born before 1st January 1952

3. ENTRY FEES & COST OF TRAINING (in Euro)

4. REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT OF THE ENTRY FEES

The shooters can enter and pay their entry fees via the FITASC's website (www.fitasc.com), or directly to the Nicosia Shooting Club.

All shooters taking part in international competition under the FITASC auspices must have a license issued by the FITASC member Federation in their country of nationality. Any shooters domiciled in a country other than their nationality holding solely a license issued by FITASC member Federation of their country of residence will not be entitled to take part in international competitions under their nationality. National Federations may check at any time whether the entrants via the FITASC site comply with these rules. Any shooters with dual nationality, must, when registering their first entry, choose the nationality for which they are entered (and must shoot under this nationality for the following three years) and have a license issued by the FITASC member Federation of the chosen country.

Following the decision of the Ordinary General Meeting of August 14, 2012, any Federation member of FITASC is committed to deliver for free to expatriate:

- A license for the duration of the Championship concerned
- As well as liability insurance if the National Federation covers its affiliates in the country shooters.
