Importation of Firearms into Australia

Please Note – Semi Automatic shotguns are not allowed to be imported into Australia for our Clay Target Events. Visitors are only allowed to import Break Action Shotguns.

To compete and import firearms into Australia you will need to apply to:
The Firearms Registry in the Australian State of arrival

A Competition Entry Invitation letter. Your personal Invitation letter is available by Emailing the SCA National Office with your Name – Address – Contact mobile number – This letter will be returned back to your contact Email address.

To bring firearms, ammunition, parts, or accessories you already own into Queensland, Australia you will be required to apply for the following: The Following is information arriving into Queensland, **If you are not entering Queensland first, you need to contact the relevant [interstate firearm registries](#).**

- International Visitors Firearm Permit = VP Form 38 – **Note an application minimum of 42 days prior to arrival**

- Go online prior to applying for your VP Form 38 & complete a Police Import B709A Application form for the Importation of Firearms and Parts' (B709A). This form can be completed & applied for online. You will require a copy of this form authorized by QLD Police before you send off the VP 36 form & fee.

Completed Import Application **B709** & Visitor permit forms **38** (Along with VP Fee) should be forwarded to: Queensland Police

To Export your Firearms when Departing from Australia **Applying for a Restricted Goods Permit**

- You will first need to register as a Client for an **Integrated cargo number** form B319

You will also require an **Export declaration** from Australian Customs - B957- Restricted Goods Permit and Export Declaration.

Both completed (& Customs Countersigned) forms B319 & B957 need to be presented to the Australian Customs office prior to departure at the Airport.

Application of these forms (B319 & B957) will not be accepted by Australian Customs before a maximum of 28 days prior to departure.

These completed forms can be presented & dropped off at the Airport Australian Customs office 28 Days prior to Travel. It is advised these forms are delivered to the Australian Customs office several days minimum before departure. **DO NOT DO THIS ON THE DAY OF YOUR TRAVEL.**

It is advised to download & complete these forms prior to departing for Australia

Prior to your Australian departure you will have to present these Customs signed forms along with your Visitors Permit (VP 38) to Australian Customs Office at the departing Airport. It is advisable to allow at least **two hours extra** prior to check in to finalise the Export process.

Visitor Visa entry requirements

Regarding visitor personal Visa requirements. It would be necessary to check with Australian Embassies in your country to ascertain whether a Visa into Australia is required by you, or not.
