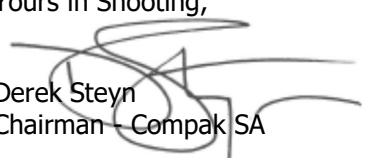

You can obtain your **Temporary Export/Import Permit** at the **Johannesburg (O R Tambo) International airport**, provided that you have the following documents:

1. SAPS 520 – **attached hereto.**
2. Your country's license for the firearm **PLUS proof of permission to export from your country of origin**
3. Your passport
4. Invitation Letter from Compak SA
5. Visitors may bring their own shotgun and a limited amount of ammunition (5kgs or 175 x 28 gram cartridges) into South Africa. We do, however, strongly suggest that you arrange to purchase ammunition in South Africa – it is far less complicated than trying to travel with ammunition.
6. You can apply in advance for your permit (see below) and it should be authorised in Pretoria by the South African Police Services (SAPS) before you leave your own country. Please allow a MINIMUM of 30 days for processing.
7. It is possible to obtain the authorisation / permit at the South African "Port of Entry" although if you are in a group, it can be very time consuming. As is usually the case when transporting firearms and ammunition, they must be packed and secured in separate security cases.
8. **Please be aware that the South African authorities require you to present a proof of permission to export from your country of origin. This applies to ALL applicants from ALL countries.**

Application form to bring in a shotgun in South Africa

These invitation letters are valid only if accompanied by a properly completed SAPS520 application form as required under the Firearms Control Act 60 of 2000 (as amended). For any help to fill in the form, please click [here](#).

Your completed documentation (all documents to be completed in black ink) must be handed in at the Firearms Desk of Cape Town airport, where the attending Police Officer will ensure that your permit is supplied on production of this letter and the properly completed documents.

Firearm licence or ownership certificate

Every shooter will also need to bring with him his firearms licence or a document proving ownership of his firearm(s): for instance, the European Firearm Permit for EEC residents.

Visitors may bring their own shotgun (1 ONLY) and a limited amount of ammunition (5kgs or 175 x 28 gram cartridges) into South Africa. We do, however, strongly suggest that you arrange to purchase ammunition in South Africa – it is far less complicated than trying to travel with ammunition. You can apply in advance for your permit (see below) and it should be authorised in Pretoria by the South African Police Services (SAPS) before you leave your own country. Please allow a MINIMUM of 30 days for processing.
